

**RESOLUTION NO. 110-2016**

**RESOLUTION DECLARING VALID MATNOG MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02-2016 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOG, PROVINCE OF SORSOGON, PRESCRIBING FEES AND PENALTIES THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."**

**WHEREAS**, submitted for consideration of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan was Matnog Municipal Ordinance No. 02-2016;

**WHEREAS**, the SP Joint Committees on Transportation, Communication & Utilities, and Rules, Privileges & Amendments to which the subject ordinance was referred, conducted a hearing on June 21, 2016 and submitted the following findings and recommendation:

***FINDINGS / RECOMMENDATION:***

1. *That the ordinance was enacted within the prescribed powers of the SB provided for by the Local Government Code of 1991. Hence, the same is intra vires.*
2. *Most of the provisions of the ordinance were adopted from RA 4136. Also, there are provisions in the subject ordinance that are in support of the newly enacted provincial ordinance of this august body which aims to prescribe rules and regulations on the utilization of road expansion project in Daang Maharlika found within the bounds of the provincial government of Sorsogon.*
3. *There are some issues and concerns that were raised during the hearing:*

*3.1. Under Section 3, Definition of Terms:*

*3.1.1. The definition of Traffic Enforcer must show that said LGU employee had undergone necessary training conducted by LTO insofar as the implementation of traffic rules and regulations is concerned.*

*3.1.2. As to the width of public road, its determination must be in accordance with pertinent law*

- 3.2. In addition to Section 7, it was suggested that the Mayor be empowered to create a local traffic management board, which the mayor shall be heading. Its composition and functions may be provided in another section.
- 3.3. In Section 8, traffic aids mentioned herein must be deputized by the LGU/LTO, whichever is proper.
- 3.4. In Section 11 (b), the SB is hereby advised to visit the enacted Provincial Ordinance of the province of Sorsogon, particularly Section 4, restriction as to speed, thereof. Moreover, it is hereby suggested that for clarity, "Business" as used in this section must be defined or at least identified.
- 3.5. To delete Sections 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35. These provisions speak of different subject matters. Moreover, as confirmed by the SB Secretary, the same are already included in the LGU's ordinance on regulation of operation of tricycles-for-hire in the municipality. Consequently, Sections 36 to 47 shall be numbered 31 to 41.
- 3.6. In Section 37 of the ordinance, it was not made clear what action shall be observed after the lapse of the 7-day reglementary period within which violator can pay his fines. It is hereby advised, that such provision be included, for clarity of the course of action.
- 3.7. In Section 40, the "renewal of the driver's license" shall be deleted. In the same section, it was suggested that there must be a specific time frame within which the said monthly report will be submitted to LTO. As agreed, the monthly report shall be submitted not later than five (5) calendar days of the ensuing month.
- 3.8. In Section 42 (d) "Section 12 to 24" shall be charged to "Section 11 to 24".
4. The Joint Committees resolved to recommend to declare Matnog Municipal Ordinance valid, and further recommends for the passage of a resolution to its effect.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Dennis Alfonso L. Escudero, duly seconded by Hon. Neson A. Maraña, the Board **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **DONE**, to **DECLARE VALID MATNOG MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02-2016 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOG, PROVINCE OF SORSOGON, PRESCRIBING FEES AND PENALTIES THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."**

## MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02-2015

### **AN ORDINANCE ENFORCING EMERGENCY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT DURING DISASTERS, CALAMITIES, INCLEMENT WEATHER AND OTHER ABNORMAL SITUATIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOG**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MATNOG THAT

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as the Emergency Traffic Management Ordinance

Section 2. General Provisions

1. It is hereby imposed that during the occurrence of disasters, calamities, inclement weather and other abnormal situation that disrupt the normal flow of traffic along the roads in Matnog, this emergency traffic management ordinance will be strictly enforced.
2. As soon as the port becomes congested with vehicles due to cancellation of vessel trips, lack of vessels, slow turnaround of vessels and other unusual circumstances, the incoming vehicles will be stopped at the highway along Brgy. Sulangan by traffic enforcers duly commissioned by the Mayor or by PNP personnel. At the stop point, the drivers of the vehicles will be instructed to go to their designated parking space or holding area.
3. The Diversion road along Brgy. Gadgaron and Brgy. Caloocan is hereby designated as the holding area for passenger busses and should be open always at any given time.
4. The National Highway from Brgy. Sulangan to Brgy. Laboy is hereby designated as holding areas for trucks and trailers.
5. The First Come First Serve Policy will be strictly implemented to instill order among stranded vehicles such as cars, busses, trucks and trailers by the duly commissioned Traffic Enforcers of the LGU or PNP personnel.
6. It shall be unlawful for any driver of both private and public vehicles going to Visayas and Mindanao, or any person to wilfully disregard or violate the implementation of the first come first serve policy under this emergency traffic ordinance in the Municipality of Matnog.
7. Parking of vehicles along 50 meters span of intersections and curves/bridges is strictly prohibited.
8. Parking of vehicles in front of schools, barangay halls, and religious institutions is not allowed.

9. Vehicles identified as carrying dangerous cargoes such as gasoline, chemical waste, toxic materials, etc., shall not be allowed to park along populated areas and shall go directly to the port.
10. Trucks loaded with perishable items such as vegetables, fruits, eggs, fish, frozen foods, etc. and government vehicles involved in disaster operations shall be given priority in the queue.

### Section 3. Services by the Local Government Unit

1. Traffic Management
  - a. The LGU will provide Traffic Enforcers, PNP personnel and Barangay Police to supervise and manage the orderly flow of traffic along the highways and holding areas.
2. Security
  - a. The LGU will deploy security personnel, police men and Barangay police to ensure safety and security of shippers and motorists.
3. Road Cleanliness Maintenance
  - a. Cleanliness and proper hygiene will be ensured by the LGU by dispatching street cleaners and providing designated restrooms.
4. Motorist Assistance Booth
  - a. This booth will be manned by LGU personnel 24 hours daily to give assistance to all motorists to provide vital information for fast and safe travel. Communication facilities will be stationed here that could be used during emergencies.
  - b. First Aiders will be stationed in the booth for immediate response in emergency incidents.

### Section 4. Imposition of Service Fee

1. There is hereby imposed a service fee in the amount of P50.00 to all vehicles parked along the highway of Brgy. Sulangan up to Brgy. Laboy, Diversion road along Brgy. Caloocan and other roads or government lot used as temporary holding areas of stranded vehicles during disasters, calamities, inclement weather and other abnormal situations for the services mentioned above rendered by LGU personnels and Brgy. Officials.

### Section 5. Collection and Disposition of Service Fees

1. The Service fee will be collected by duly authorized personnel of the Municipal Treasurer. Official receipts will be issued for this service fee. All collected fees will be deposited daily by the treasurer to a trust fund.
2. All collected fees will be disposed as follows; Seventy five percent (75 %) will go to the Municipal Treasurers Office and twenty five percent (25%) will go to the Barangays who will support and participate in the implementation of the ordinance. All proceeds shall only be used for the implementation of this ordinance.

### Section 6. Penal Provision

1. Any person found violating any provision of this ordinance will be governed by the following:
  - a. First offense - 1,000.00
  - b. Second offense - 1,500.00
  - c. Third offense - 2,000.00

All offenses will be issued with corresponding official citation tickets issued by the Municipal treasurer.

The local PNP personnel and the duly commissioned traffic enforcers are hereby authorized to temporarily confiscate the driver's license or plate number of the offenders and immediately turnover the same to the office of the Treasurer. Upon payment of the corresponding fines by the offenders, the office of the Treasurer shall immediately release the confiscated license or plate number and shall issue official receipts accordingly.

**Section 7. Disposition of collected Fines**

All collected fines under this ordinance shall be deposited in a trust fund by the Municipal Treasurer. The fund will be used for the operational requirements in the implementation of this ordinance.

**Section 8. Separability Clause**

If any provision of this ordinance or any application of its provision is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder thereof shall not be affected by such declaration.


**Section 9. Repealing Clause.**


Any ordinance, rules and regulations or parts of which are inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

**Section 10. Effectivity.**

This ordinance shall take effect after the period of publication for three consecutive weeks in any local newspaper of general circulation and after posting in three conspicuous places for three consecutive weeks.

### RESOLUTION NO. 124-2015

**RESOLUTION DECLARING VALID MATNOG MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02, SERIES OF 2015 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ENFORCING EMERGENCY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT DURING DISASTERS, CALAMITIES, INCLEMENT WEATHER AND OTHER ABNORMAL SITUATIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOG."**

**WHEREAS**, submitted for consideration of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan was Matnog Municipal Ordinance No. 02, Series of 2015;

**WHEREAS**, the SP Joint Committee on Disaster Management & Preparedness; and, Public Order & Security to which the subject ordinance was referred, conducted a hearing on June 11, 2015 and submitted the following findings and recommendation:

1. The LGU through the subject ordinance aims to instill order by enforcing emergency traffic management measures during disasters, calamities and abnormal weather conditions.
2. The author explained to the Joint Committees that there is a noticeable increase in the number of buses, trucks and other vehicles passing Matnog Port resulting to traffic congestion. He added that due to the rehabilitation efforts on infrastructures extended by the national government and other organizations and agencies to the Visayas, there is a influx of delivery trucks mostly coming from Manila and other parts of Luzon. This adds up to traffic congestion. Also, abnormal weather conditions aggravate traffic congestion
3. That these vehicles would occupy part of the national highway stretching to almost 12 kilometers, with an estimate of 500 parked vehicles, ranging from delivery trucks to trailer trucks and buses.
4. That the stranded passengers and drivers requested for services such as security, cleaner roads, medical assistance and clean restrooms from the LGU during such occurrences. The LGU consulted the stakeholders about the imposition of a one-time-per-event service fee for every vehicle, which shall only be collected during disasters, calamities or abnormal weather conditions where parked vehicles may be

seen in the highway of Matnog leading to Matnog Port. Hence, the imposition of the P50.00 service fee provided under Section 4 for services listed in Section 3 of the subject ordinance.

The issue on the legality of the collection of service fee was raised. Hence, the Committee resolved to seek technical assistance from the Department of Interior and Local Government Sorsogon Provincial Office on the matter.

Unfortunately, the Joint Committees were informed that the imposition of service fee, as provided under Section 4 of the ordinance in question qualifies as a "pass through fee", which the Department in its Memorandum Circular No. 2011-122 dated August 26, 2011 (Suspension of LGU Impositions and Collection of Pass Through Fees) advised LGUs that charging of fees, taxes and other charges on the transportation of goods and passengers carried into or out of, passing through the respective territorial jurisdictions of such LGUs in the guise of sticker fee, discharging fee, delivery fee, market fee, toll fee and mayor's permit fee, among other are beyond the taxing powers of the LGUs pursuant to Section 133 (e) of RA 7160. In the same issuance Section 133 (e) of RA 7160 was reiterated, to wit:

**"SECTION 133. Common Limitations on the Taxing Power of Local Government Units.** *Unless otherwise provided herein, the exercise of the taxing powers of provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays shall not extend to levy the following:*

*(e) Taxes, fees, charges and other impositions upon goods carries into or out of, or passing through, the territorial jurisdiction of local government units in the guise of charges for wharfage, tolls for bridges or otherwise, or other taxes, fees or charges in any form whatsoever upon such goods and merchandise;"*

As a general rule, service fees may be collected by the LGU for the use of facilities and structures if such facilities or structures are being maintained and operated by the said LGU. In this case, said vehicles are parked along the national highway and not in a holding area maintained and operated by the local government unit of Matnog. Therefore, the imposition of such service fee cannot be given due course.

Moreover, it is inherent to the LGU to provide security, safer and cleaner roads, and other social services to its constituents and to all those individuals passing through their territorial jurisdiction.


Therefore, Section 4 of the subject ordinance is hereby declared invalid.

5. In Section 6, 3rd paragraph, said PNP personnel and traffic enforcers must be duly deputized by the Land Transportation Office. Hence, it is hereby advised to indicate in the ordinance that only deputized local PNP personnel and traffic enforcers shall be authorized to temporarily confiscate the driver's license or plate number of the offenders.
6. Foregoing premises considered, the Joint Committees hereby resolved to recommend to the august body to declare Matnog Ordinance No. 02, Series of 2015 valid except as to the Imposition of Service Fee, inviting, the attention of the Sangguniang Bayan to above-findings for its consideration and appropriate action. Pursuant to its Separability Clause, other provisions therein are not affected, hence the ordinance is valid. Moreover, the passage of the requisite resolution to its effect is also recommended.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** on motion of Hon. Bernard H. Hao, duly seconded by Hon. Rolando R. Añonuevo, the Board **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **DONE**, to **DECLARE VALID MATNOC MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02, SERIES OF 2015 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ENFORCING EMERGENCY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT DURING DISASTERS, CALAMITIES, INCLEMENT WEATHER AND OTHER ABNORMAL SITUATIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOC."**

10. Trucks loaded with perishable items such as vegetables, fruits, eggs, fish, frozen foods, etc. and government vehicles involved in disaster operations shall be given priority in the queue.

### Section 3. Services by the Local Government Unit

1. Traffic Management
  - a. The LGU will provide Traffic Enforcers, PNP personnel and Barangay Police to supervise and manage the orderly flow of traffic along the highways and holding areas.
2. Security
  - a. The LGU will deploy security personnel, police men and Barangay police to ensure safety and security of shippers and motorists.
3. Road Cleanliness Maintenance
  - a. Cleanliness and proper hygiene will be ensured by the LGU by dispatching street cleaners and providing designated restrooms.
4. Motorist Assistance Booth
  - a. This booth will be manned by LGU personnel 24 hours daily to give assistance to all motorists to provide vital information for fast and safe travel. Communication facilities will be stationed here that could be used during emergencies.
  - b. First Aiders will be stationed in the booth for immediate response in emergency incidents.

### Section 4. Imposition of Service Fee

1. There is hereby imposed a service fee in the amount of P50.00 to all vehicles parked along the highway of Brgy. Sulangan up to Brgy. Laboy, Diversion road along Brgy. Caloocan and other roads or government lot used as temporary holding areas of stranded vehicles during disasters, calamities, inclement weather and other abnormal situations for the services mentioned above rendered by LGU personnels and Brgy. Officials.

### Section 5. Collection and Disposition of Service Fees

1. The Service fee will be collected by duly authorized personnel of the Municipal Treasurer. Official receipts will be issued for this service fee. All collected fees will be deposited daily by the treasurer to a trust fund.
2. All collected fees will be disposed as follows; Seventy five percent (75 %) will go to the Municipal Treasurers Office and twenty five percent (25%) will go to the Barangays who will support and participate in the implementation of the ordinance. All proceeds shall only be used for the implementation of this ordinance.

### Section 6. Penal Provision

1. Any person found violating any provision of this ordinance will be governed by the following:
 

a. First offense	-	1,000.00
b. Second offense	-	1,500.00
c. Third offense	-	2,000.00

All offenses will be issued with corresponding official citation tickets issued by the Municipal treasurer.

The local PNP personnel and the duly commissioned traffic enforcers are hereby authorized to temporarily confiscate the driver's license or plate number of the offenders and immediately turnover the same to the office of the Treasurer. Upon payment of the corresponding fines by the offenders, the office of the Treasurer shall immediately release the confiscated license or plate number and shall issue official receipts accordingly.

**Section 7. Disposition of collected Fines**

All collected fines under this ordinance shall be deposited in a trust fund by the Municipal Treasurer. The fund will be used for the operational requirements in the implementation of this ordinance.

**Section 8. Separability Clause**

If any provision of this ordinance or any application of its provision is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder thereof shall not be affected by such declaration.

**Section 9. Repealing Clause.**

Any ordinance, rules and regulations or parts of which are inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

**Section 10. Effectivity.**


This ordinance shall take effect after the period of publication for three consecutive weeks in any local newspaper of general circulation and after posting in three conspicuous places for three consecutive weeks.

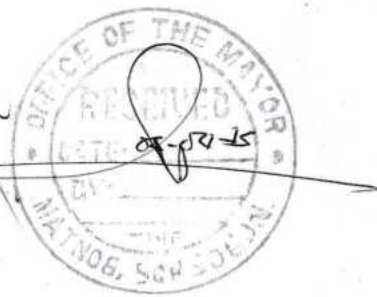




