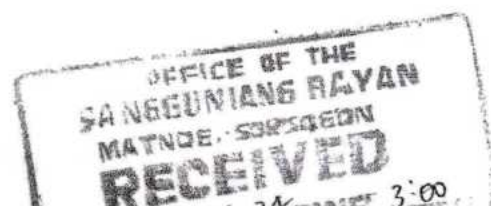

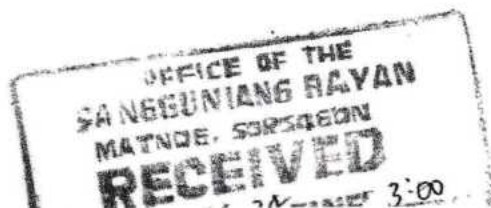

Municipal Ordinance No. 03 - 2012

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING USER'S FEE ON ALL VEHICLES BOUND FOR VISAYAS AND MINDANAO UTILIZING THE MATNOG INTEGRATED TRANSPORT TERMINAL (MITT) IN MATNOG, SORSOGON
 Author: Honorable Christopher G. Hadap

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN in session assembled, that:

Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as "User's Fee Ordinance on All Vehicles Bound for Visayas and Mindanao Utilizing the Matnog Integrated Transport Terminal (MITT) in Matnog, Sorsogon.

Section 2. Scope. This ordinance shall apply to all vehicles utilizing the MITT bound for Visayas and Mindanao.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

1. Bicycle - A vehicle consisting of a light frame mounted on two wire-spoked wheels one behind the other and having a seat, handlebars for steering, brakes, and two pedals or a small motor by which it is driven.
2. Bus - A long motor vehicle for carrying passengers, usually along a fixed route
3. Motorcycle - a two-wheeled (or, if equipped with a sidecar, three-wheeled) vehicle propelled by an internal-combustion engine and resembling a bicycle, but usually larger and heavier, and often having two saddles
4. Small vehicle - with carrying capacity of not more than 13 passengers
5. Sidecar - A one-wheeled car for a single passenger, attached to the side of a motorcycle.
6. Truck - 3 seating capacity such as forward, 6 wheeler, 10 wheeler
7. Trailer - at least 20 footer length

Section 4. Imposition. There is hereby imposed the following entry fee:

Trailer	Php75.00
Truck	50.00
Bus	35.00
Small Vehicle	25.00
Motorcycle with sidecar	20.00
Motorcycle	15.00
Bicycle with sidecar	10.00
Bicycle	5.00

Section 5. Penalties. Drivers violating any provision of this ordinance shall be made to pay a fine or shall be punished as follows:


First Offense	:	P500.00
Second Offense	:	P1,000.00
Third Offense	:	P2,500.00 and/or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months upon discretion of the court.

Section 6. Separability Clause. If any part of this ordinance is declared as unconstitutional or unlawful, such declaration shall not affect the other parts or sections hereof that are not declared unlawful or unconstitutional.


Section 7. Repealing Clause. All previous ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 8. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take ^{effect} after publication in a newspaper of general circulation and posting in three conspicuous places for three (3) consecutive weeks.



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY MAYORS, MUNICIPAL
MAYORS, PUNONG BARANGAYS, DILG REGIONAL
DIRECTORS AND OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : SUSPENSION OF LGU IMPOSITION AND COLLECTION OF
ILLEGAL FEES AND TAXES

In the meeting of the President with the transport sector on 14 September 2011, it was reported that LGUs are still imposing and collecting illegal fees and taxes particularly on trucks and similar motor vehicles passing thru their jurisdiction.

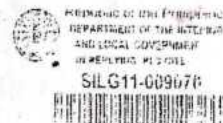
Pursuant thereto, the President instructed the Department to ensure that LGUs are not imposing and collecting pass through fees and other illegal collections.

In view thereof, and pursuant to Section 133(e) of the Code, all local chief executives are hereby enjoined to:

- (1) refrain from enforcing any existing ordinance authorizing the levy of fees and taxes on inter-province transport of goods, regulatory fees from passengers in local ports, and other additional taxes, fees or charges in any form upon transporting goods and passengers; and
- (2) cause the immediate repeal of the ordinance imposing the abovesited fees and taxes.

All DILG Regional Directors are likewise hereby enjoined to cause the immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular within their regional assignment, and to report to the Office of the undersigned non-complaint/violators of this directive for the institution of appropriate cases against those concerned officials.


