### MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 05 s. 2006

#### **AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING A NEW SCHEDULE OF PASSENGER FARE RATES FOR MOTORIZED TRIMOBILES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOG, AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03-2004**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguninag Bayan of Matnog, that,

**SECTION 1.** This ordinance shall be known as the *new schedule of fare rates for motorized trimobiles* within the municipality of Matnog and the amendment to pertinent provisions of the existing Municipal Ordinance No. 03-2004

**SECTION 2.** Schedule fare Rates of Motorized Trimobiles:

- A. First two kilometers
 

1. Minimum Fare	P6.00
2. Special Fare	
a. Elementary students	P4.00
b. High school and college students	P5.00
c. Senior citizens / disabled persons	P5.00
  
- B. In excess of two (2) kilometers additional of one (1) peso per kilometer shall be added accordingly.
  
- C. The following barangays are not included in the same computation due to road condition:
 

	Student	Regular
C.1. Banogao	P8.00	P13.00
C.2. Balocawe	P7.00	P9.00
C.3. Sinebaran	P7.00	P10.00
C.4. Sta. Isabel	P7.00	P13.00

In the event that the barangay roads of the same are constructed, the fare rate shall be based as scheduled.

**ORDAINED FURHTERMORE, that;**

1. All public utility shall be provided, in a dialect, a copy of this ordinance, which the operator or driver shall display prominently inside the vehicle;
2. There shall be provided further, that a schedule of rates to distance of barangays shall be provided every public utility vehicle, which shall also be put on display for the passengers to read.

**SECTION 3. PENALTY CLAUSE-** any person found violating this Ordinance, that is, by overcharging shall be penalized, to wit;

1. **First offense-** a fine of P200.00 and one (1) week suspension of the driver violator from using any trimobile for hire within the municipality
2. **Second offense-** a fine of P300.00 and one (1) month suspension of the driver violator from using any trimobile for hire within the municipality
3. **Third offense-** a fine of P500.00 and three (3) months suspension of the driver violator from using any trimobile for hire within the municipality. it shall also be the right of the municipal Government to confiscate and revoke the MTOP of the vehicle;
4. All vehicles of all driver violators apprehended for overcharging shall be impounded under the jurisdiction of the Municipal PNP until such time that the financial penalties due are paid.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE-** Any Ordinance, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provision of this Municipal Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY-** This ordinance shall take effect immediately one week after its passage, provided, however, that the riding public shall be properly informed by the radio broadcast of this ordinance.



**Barangay Ordinance No. 04 s. 2010**

AN ORDINANCE TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT THE EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND ORDINANCES GOVERNING ILLEGAL GAMBLING IN BARANGAY CAMCAMAN, MATNOG, SORSOGON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Barangay of Camcaman, Matnog, Sorsogon, that;

**Section 1. Prohibition** – it shall be unlawful for any persons to engage in illegal gambling that impairs local economic growth because the money earned by the marginalized sectors are being shifted to operators for their perilous activities.

**Section 2. Penalty** - violation of this Barangay Ordinance shall impose a fine or penalties corresponding to the amount or imprisonment, sanctioned by the law.

**Section 2.1. for the first offense** – offense shall meted a fine of Php200.00 pesos and one (1) day community service.


**Section 2.2. for the second offense** – Php350.00 and two (2) days community service performing solely in the maintenance of beautification.

**Section 2.3. for third offense** – the offender shall be meted a fine of Php500.00 or Php1,000.00 pesos or imprisonment of two (2) days or four (4) days community service, respectively.


**Section 3. person/ persons authorized to implement this ordinance**  
- The Barangay Officials, Barangay Tanods and PNP are hereby deputized to implement this ordinance. All payments made as fine in violation of any section of this ordinance shall be paid to the Barangay Treasurer where the offense has been committed and shall issue a corresponding receipt.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall take effect upon the approval and thorough deliberation and review of the Sangguniang Bayan members.
