RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CONTRACEPTIVE SELF RELIANCE PLUS (CSR+) PLAN OF MATNOG, SORSOGON AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF

WHEREAS, section 12, Article II of the Philippines Constitution provides that the State recognizes the sanctity of family as a basic institution and it shall equally protect the life of the mother and the life of the unborn from conception and Section 14 of the same Article also provides that the State shall protect the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, section II, Article XIII of the constitution likewise provide the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essentials goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost and that, there shall be a priority for the needs of the underprivileged sick elderly, disabled, woman and children;

WHEREAS, it is provided in the Local Government code of 1991 under Section 17 that the Government Units shall discharge the functions and responsibilities of the national agencies and offices devolved to them and shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, it is within the power of the Sangguniang Bayan as provided under Section 447 (5) to approve ordinances, which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities enumerated in Section 17 of the LGC of 1991;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Romeo G. Garalde duly seconded by Hon. Jaime G. Gata, Jr., it was resolved, to enact;

Municipal Ordinance No. 06-2006

AND ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CONTRACEPTIVE SELF-RELIANCE PLUS (CSR+) PLAN OF MATNOC, SORSOGON AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matnog, that:

SECTION 1. Title - This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Adopting the Contraceptive Self-Reliance Plus (CSR+) Plan of Matnog, Sorsogon".

SECTION 2. Definition of Terms - For better understanding, the following terms and phrases are hereby defined as used in this ordinance:

- a. Program - shall refer to CSR+ (Family Planning, TB-DOTS, STI/HIV AIDS) as established in this ordinance
- b. CSR+CSS Indigent - shall mean families whose gross household income per month is not more than Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00)
- c. Member - shall refer to the members of the program
- d. Dependents - shall refer to the qualified dependents of the member
- e. Health Care Providers - shall refer to all health workers in the community.

SECTION 3. Objectives - In order to respond to the health care needs of the indigent family, the program seeks to achieve the following objectives:

- a. Increase budgetary allocation;
- b. Sustain the inadequacy program enrollees
- c. Maintain health care facilities and equipment to attain a better than midrange satisfaction rating as per service satisfaction scale to be set by the concerned office;
- d. Realize at least a 20% improvement in efficiency and effectiveness of the CSR+ services annually.

SECTION 4. Program Benefits

- a. Access to family planning commodities
- b. Reduce risk of mortality due to high risk pregnancies
- c. Reduce growth rate from 1.88 to 1.6
- d. Reduce morbidity/mortality due to Vitamin A deficiency
- e. Reduce morbidity/mortality due to TB
- f. Increase detection of TB
- g. Increase cure rate of TB
- h. Improve surveillance system of HIV/AIDS

SECTION 5. Support Units

- a. Department of Health (DOH) - renders technical assistance
- b. Local Government Unit (LGU) - provides financial support
- c. PHIC Capitation Fund - augmentation fund from the PHIC to the health needs of the RHU
- d. Barangay - provides additional funds

SECTION 6. Performance Management and Fund Allocation - Rural Health Unit shall prepare performance indicators and annual performance targets for the services rendered to Asses the output of the CSR+ Plan. An amount of Two Hundred Thousand (P 200,000.00) Pesos from the 20%CDF of the Municipality shall be appropriated for the implementation of this ordinance and the same amount every year thereafter for its continuity.


SECTION 7. Amendatory and Repealing Clause – any ordinance or executive issuance or any part thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are thereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity – this Ordinance shall take effect after its posting in three conspicuous places within the municipality or after publication in a newspaper of general circulation for three (3) consecutive weeks.

Dear Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan Concerned:

The Office of the Mayor respectfully returns Resolution No. 38 s. 2006 with the following comments:

Sec. 2.b CSR & CSS Indigent

If the basis is per month income of Php 4,000.00 what will be the comparison of this income between a small and a big family of the same income bracket? Would it not be safe if we use per capita income? Say, monthly income divided by the number of family members....

Sec. 2.c. Members

Would it be safe if we use the term "beneficiary" instead of "member" since this is a program not a club or an organization?

Sec. 2.d. Dependents

Are dependents of the beneficiaries entitled to health benefits and or other benefit emanating from being dependents of TB, STI/HIVAIDS victims?

Sec. 3.b.

The Mayor's Office believes that this objective is to be reworded since we are dealing with three different programs thus:

b.1 to minimize the number of TV/STI/HIV AIDS victims/carriers in the municipality; and

b.2. to increase the number of family planning acceptors.

Sec. 4.c.

Reduce growth rate from 1.88 to 1.6. What growth are we referring to in this program?

Sec. 4.c.

This should not be included here since surveillance system of HIV/AIDS falls in the hands of PNAC.

Sec.6.

The Mayor's Office believes that LGU Matnog had spent something like Php 400,000.00 for this program last year. Php 200,000.00 may not be enough for this program since family planning contraceptives shall not be given free this time.

Should it be safe if we say:

An amount of Php _____ from the 20% CDF of the municipality shall be appropriated for implementation of this ordinance and appropriate amount based on the present needs of this program every year thereafter for its continuity.
