

**WHEREAS,** submitted for consideration of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, were the above-cited Matnog Municipal Ordinance Nos. 06 and 08, all Series of 2011;

**WHEREAS,** the SP Joint Committees on Ways & Means, Environment & Natural Resources, Youth Sports Development and Rules, Privileges & Amendments to which the subject municipal Ordinances were referred, submitted the following findings and recommendations, to wit:

**On Ordinance No. 06**

1. That the LGU through the ordinance aims to collect a reasonable amount from any person passing through the Matnog Port. The said amount shall be put in a trust fund, where the same will be utilized for the "operations of the local Solid Waste Management" among others, as stipulated under Section 4 of the ordinance. However, it also specifically stated that such fund shall be used for "food assistance" for stranded passengers during typhoon. If the LGU is invoking its revenue generating power on solid management under Section 12 (4) of RA 9003, then the food assistance cannot be cited as one of its utilization. Section 12 (4) specifically provides to "Adopt specific revenue-generating measures to promote the viability of its Solid Waste Management Plan."

2. If infants and children are to be exempted from paying the environmental fee, then such exemption should be stipulated in the ordinance.
3. Also, the SB's attention is invited to Article 219 (c) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 7160 as regards to Section 6 of the subject ordinance.
4. Moreover, on Section 6, the imposition of fines and/or penalties must be in accordance with what was provided under Section 447 (1) (iii) of RA 7160.
5. In view of the foregoing premises, the Joint Committee hereby resolved to return the subject ordinance to the municipality of origin without action.

**On Ordinance No. 08**

1. That there is a necessity to identify specific problems/issues that the LGU will be addressing through the subject ordinance. Apparently, the ordinance wishes to address participation of minors in betting in computer games inside computer shops or internet cafes, billiard halls or any other business establishment or facilities located within their territorial jurisdiction.
2. In the Title of the ordinance – The words “amusement center” may include parks, theaters and other gaming center where minors may be allowed, with or without a guardian or an adult companion. In view of this, it is suggested that the word “amusement center” be changed to “business establishment or facilities”. Also, these words should be defined under Section 2.
3. That in fact there is no need to pass this ordinance because the protection of minors and prohibition of betting of minors are already provided under existing laws, However, in deference to the local government of Matnog, the Committee hereby resolved to recommend that the subject ordinance be returned without action to the municipality of origin for its information and/or appropriate action.





## MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 08-2011

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AMUSEMENT CENTERS OR PLACES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOC TO PERMIT MINORS PLAY OR LOITER IN ANY OF ITS FACILITIES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF**

Sponsor: Honorable Ernie G. Garcera

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matnog, that:

**Section 1. Prohibition.** It shall be prohibited of all amusement centers or places to permit minors to play or loiter in any of its facilities.

**Section 2. Definition of Terms.** As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. Amusement Center – refers to any place or establishment that offers entertainment facilities such as videoke bar, betting and games of chances or other similar entertainment facilities.
- b. Minors – male and female below 18 years old

**Section 3. Repealing Clause.** All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, provisions of which are in conflict with, contrary to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**Section 4. Penalties.** The operator of the amusement center or place who violates this ordinance shall suffer the following penalties:

*First Offense* – Stop working to amusecenter and a fine of FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) per minor apprehended playing the game.

*Second Offense* – Suspension of license to operate for one (1) month and a fine of ONE THOUSAND PESOS (1,000.00) per minor apprehended playing the game.

*Republic of the Philippines*  
*MUNICIPALITY OF SB*  
**Third and Subsequent Offenses** – Cancellation of license to operate, confiscation of gadgets or facilities and a fine of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P1,500.00) per minor apprehended playing the game.


Section 5. **Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take after publication in a newspaper of general circulation and posting in three conspicuous places for three (3) consecutive weeks.



## MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 08-2011

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AMUSEMENT CENTERS OR PLACES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOG TO PERMIT MINORS PLAY OR LOITER IN ANY OF ITS FACILITIES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF**

Sponsor: Honorable Ernie G. Garcera

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matnog, that:

Section 1. **Prohibition.** It shall be prohibited of all amusement centers or places to permit minors to play or loiter in any of its facilities.

Section 2. **Definition of Terms.** As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. Amusement Center – refers to any place or establishment that offers entertainment facilities such as videoke bar, betting and games of chances or other similar entertainment facilities.
- b. Minors – male and female below 18 years old

Section 3. **Repealing Clause.** All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, provisions of which are in conflict with, contrary to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 4. **Penalties.** The operator of the amusement center or place who violates this ordinance shall suffer the following penalties:

**First Offense** – Stern warning to owner/operator and a fine of FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) per minor apprehended playing the game.

**Second Offense** – Suspension of license to operate for one (1) month and a fine of ONE THOUSAND PESOS (1,000.00) per minor apprehended playing the game.

**Third and Subsequent Offenses** - Cancellation of license to operate, confiscation of gadgets or facilities and a fine of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P1,500.00) per minor apprehended playing the game.


Section 5. **Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take after publication in a newspaper of general circulation and posting in three conspicuous places for three (3) consecutive weeks.
