WHEREAS, the realignment involves the unexpended balances for the CY 2017 of the LGU’s 20% Municipal Development Fund in the total amount of P3,875,315.26, and the new identified projects subject of the realignment are incorporated in the municipality’s 2018 AIP duly authorized by the Local Development Council per Resolution No. 01 S. 2018.

WHEREAS, the amount realigned cannot be disbursed without the corresponding appropriation ordinance considering that the realignment pertains to the CY 2017 unexpended balances of the 20% development fund. Also, the change in the projects to be funded by the said realignment requires the authority through a supplemental budget enacted under an appropriation ordinance;
